Mineral backbone gives good balance with a long finish. An English wine in the Gewürztraminer style. Will come to perfection a year after October harvest.</i>
	<b>Battle Royal</b> 2017  12.5%	Bronze medal	Dry rosé still	<i>Salmon pink colour. Crisp and refreshing on the palate with a cranberry and lemon flavour. Strawberry on the mid-taste, and a long finish with good minerality and a hint of gooseberry. <b>SOLD OUT</b></i>
	<b>Gundog</b> 2017  11%	Varietal wine	Very dry white still	<i>Clear, pale lemon colour. Musky aroma of an autumn forest, think of walkies in the wood. Barking good taste of ripe grapefruit with lime and a hint of sherbet. Tangy, giving a bite on the foretaste similar to a dry Riesling. Spicy notes of white pepper on a lingering aftertaste. A complex, musky wine that is crisp and refreshing.</i>
	<b>King Henry</b> 2016  10.5%	PDO	Red still	<i>Deep dark red colour. Flavour of plum and black cherry with a hint of black pepper. The tannin gives a long finish with a lingering taste of blackberry. Will come to perfection 3 years after October harvest.</i>
	<b>Spirit of Freedom</b> 2013  11%	PGI  Bronze medals	Sparkling blush rosé	<i>Gorgeous blush rose colour with a beautifully creamy mousse. A dominant red currant aroma with hints of strawberry. Orion grapes bring finesse, whilst staying crisp and fresh with a long, elegant finish.</i>
	<b>Noble Purpose</b> 2014  11.5%	PGI  Silver medal	Sparkling rosé	<i>Mouth watering flavour of strawberry and pear with notes of tropical fruit all enhanced with a beautifully creamy mousse. Orion grapes bring finesse while staying crisp and fresh with a lingering finish. Perfect with canapé, fish, fruit, poultry and Asian foods. Or, drink on its own and think noble thoughts!</i>
