Or, drink on its own and think noble thoughts!</i></p> <p>Our Leicestershire vineyard is located in the historic grounds of Rothley Temple where medieval knights gathered to protect pilgrims visiting the Holyland. This movement subsequently became the St. Johns Ambulance. Later, William Wilberforce drafted the Abolition of Slavery Act there. This wine respects all those who have a noble purpose in life.</p> |
